Notes:

1. Mini Camps stay 3 nights, all other camps stay 6 nights.
2. Campers are accepted for full camp period only. It is impossible to schedule enough sessions that will not conflict with summer school, family vacations, baseball play offs, etc...
3. The Cathedral Domain is owned and financially subsidized by the Episcopal Diocese of Lexington.
4. We urge you to send your application in as soon as possible. Make sure that your place is reserved well in advance. We cannot accept applications by phone.
5. Churches of the Diocese of Lexington will be sent lists of campers applying from their church.





What Does ACA Accreditation Mean to You?

- It assures you that our camp practices have been measured against national standards and go a step beyond state regulations.
- At least once every three years an outside team of trained professionals observes this camp in session to verify compliance with over 300 standards including food service, health care, staffing, safety, and quality of our programs.

- Accreditation ensures that the camp experience is specifically designed to achieve positive outcomes for the children and adults who participate.

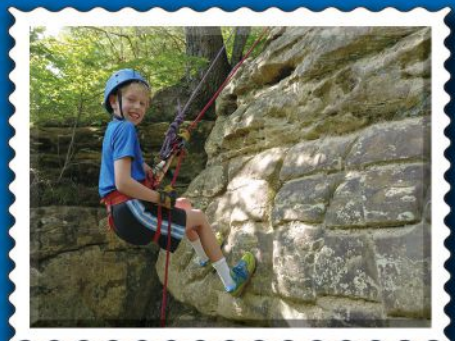
Why Choose the Cathedral Domain?

- **Location:** "The Domain" is located one and a half hours southeast of Lexington, KY. It covers 800 acres in the mountains of Lee County and is adjacent to the Daniel Boone National Forest.
- **Housing:** We use cabins generally housing 8-12 campers. All cabins have at least one bathroom as well as hot water sinks and showers. Most cabins have outside decks that overlook either the volley ball court, pool or activity field.
- **Dining:** All meals are served in the camp's Bishops' Common dining hall which maintains a Grade A health department rating. Campers will enjoy three meals a day and can select unlimited items from our salad bar. Vegetarian options are offered as well.
- **Pool:** Staffed with certified Lifeguards, the pool offers swimming and water activities.
- **Hiking:** Trained hike leaders take campers on nature hikes throughout the 800 acre property including a tour through a cave located on the premises.
- **Staff:** Staff members are chosen for their character, education, camping experience, and the example of a Christian lifestyle they can set for their campers. Paid Domain staff are certified in First Aid and CPR.
- **Spiritual Growth:** The wooden gothic cathedral overlooks the mountain, and both the outdoor Shrine and the indoor Chapel create inviting places for campers and staff to gather for opening and closing services and regular worship. Other programs and facilities include a recreation pavilion, playground, activity field, archery range, Nature Center, and repelling and rock climbing stations.



What is Included in The Fee?

- All room and board
- Camp Store - The Domain operates a small store in which water, fruit juices, sodas, snacks, fresh fruit, candy, and slush puppies are provided.
- An 8" x 10" color camp photo - The camp photo (including all campers, counselors, and staff) will be taken on Monday and given to your camper on Saturday morning. Mini-camp pictures will be mailed to the campers a few weeks after camp is over.

Scholarship info

To apply for a camp scholarship please send a letter that states your need financial help with a suggested fee of \$ 50.00 for week long sessions or \$ 25.00 for Mini Camp sessions.

The Cathedral Domain recognizes that more than 1 in 4 children in Kentucky are living in poverty. The Cathedral Domain does provide scholarships to campers in financial need, and our policy is that NO camper is turned away due to financial hardship.

Summer camp at the Cathedral Domain can be one of the most meaningful experiences in the life of a child. The tiered pricing helps families recognize the cost of camp and select the level of payment that is most appropriate for them. Families may freely choose any of the three levels, and each child will receive the same camp experience, regardless of the level selected.

For many years, expenses have been subsidized by the Cathedral Domain and the Episcopal Diocese of Lexington. While the generous support of our donors continues to make a significant impact, rising costs and our former fee structure have become unsustainable over time. We want to ensure that many generations to come will experience God's Love on the Mountain. Our tiered pricing is well below the national average, and the quality of our camper experience remains high!

Summer Camp Visitor Policy

Opening and Closing Days: On opening and closing days of camp sessions, family and friends providing transportation for campers are welcomed as visitors. Other visitors will not be allowed.

All Other Times: Visitors will not be allowed during the summer camp period, neither during nor between sessions. This does not apply to persons wishing to tour the camp facility for business reasons, to parents of prospective campers wishing to see the facility, or in emergency situations.

Camp Clothing

Informal, inexpensive clothing is recommended for camp. Please do not bring expensive items of clothing or jewelry. The Cathedral Domain cannot be responsible for articles lost or left behind. Be sure to mark all clothes and other belongings with camper's name.



Health Certificate

A current health certificate is required of all camp applicants. For your convenience, a health exam form will be mailed along with your confirmation letter. It should be completed no more than 90 days before the opening day of camp. In case of illness or injury, the health certificate provides necessary and valuable information. The health certificate and copy of the campers insurance card should be returned two weeks prior to the start of camp session.



When to Arrive and Leave

Arrival - All campers should arrive between 2:00 and 5:00 p.m.
Mini Camp II should arrive between 5:00 and 8:00 p.m.
Please Do Not Arrive Early!

Departure - the time of departure should be between 10:00 and 11:00 a.m. Please be on time. Pick up for all camps will be in the Great Hall. Remember to drive slowly!



Additional Information

In case of emergencies, the services of a local physician are quickly available. Secondary Accident Insurance for each camper is included in the camp fee. A lifeguard is on duty during all swimming periods. The Domain staff is certified in First Aid and CPR.



Campers are not permitted to use the telephone during camp, except for urgent matters, and with special permission. Parents should call only in the case of an emergency. In cases of willful destruction, parents will be asked to pay for damages.

Permission to Participate in Camp Activities

I understand and certify that my child's participation in The Cathedral Domain's activities is completely voluntary and I have familiarized myself with the camp's program and activities in which my child will be participating. I recognize that certain hazards and dangers are inherent in the Cathedral Domain's program including, but not limited to, swimming, rock climbing, repelling, hiking and caving. Although The Cathedral Domain has taken safety measures to minimize the risk of injury to camp participants, equipment, premises, and/or activities will not be free of hazards, accidents, and/or injuries.

I further recognize and have instructed my child in the importance of knowing and abiding by the camps rules, regulations, and procedures for the safety of camp participants.

Photo Permission

As the parent or guardian of the camper listed on this application, I give my permission and consent for the use of any photography or video that includes my child's image.

I further give my permission and consent that any such photographs may be used by The Episcopal Diocese of Lexington, The Cathedral Domain, or the American Camp Association to illustrate and promote the camp experience, and/or The Cathedral Domain programs.

Policy on Rooming Requests

Rooming requests may be considered, but not guaranteed. Campers may request **one** cabin mate. The request must appear on both campers' registration forms and the campers' ages and grades must be the same. It is our policy to place siblings in different cabins unless otherwise requested by a parent/guardian.

Cabin mate request

Our camp staff will work diligently and lovingly to make sure that all campers, especially those who may be feeling "new" or uncomfortable, are welcomed as members of the community of the Domain.

Cancellations

If it is necessary to cancel, inform the camp immediately in writing. In case of cancellation, \$200 of your registration fee is refundable up to 30 days before opening day of camp, \$100 for mini camps. If a camper fails to "Show Up" at a camp and advanced notification of the cancellation has not been made in writing to The Cathedral Domain, the parents or guardians will not be refunded the camp fee.

Three-tier Summer Camp Pricing for 2020

Tier 1: Full Week \$575 Mini Camp: \$285

Tier 1 pricing allows for families to pay the same cost as Tier 2, and additionally contribute towards the scholarships of other families who are in need of financial assistance.

Tier 2: Full Week \$515 Mini Camp: \$260

We offer Tier 2 to those families who recognize the value of camp and who are able to pay more of the cost of their child's summer camp experience. Each family at this level can enjoy knowing they are helping to sustain the ministry of the Cathedral Domain.

Tier 3: Full Week \$400 Mini Camp: \$200

At Tier 3 every camper's fee is partially paid by scholarship money donated by others. This Tier keeps camp affordable for as many families as possible.

Directions to The Cathedral Domain

From I-75: Take Exit 90A south on HWY 421/25 approximately 5 miles and turn left onto HWY 52 towards Irvine. After crossing the Kentucky River in Irvine, turn right at the first traffic light. Continue on HWY 52 through Irvine and Ravenna.

At the caution light in Ravenna stay straight. This will take you off 52 and onto HWY 1571. Go through the underpass and take a left in order to continue on HWY 1571. Go 8 miles until HWY 1571 dead ends into HWY 52. Take a right onto HWY 52. Go approximately 4 miles and take a left onto HWY 1746. This road takes you up the mountain and ends at the camp.

From I-64: Take the Mountain Parkway south from Winchester. Go 16 miles to the Clay City exit. Take a left onto HWY 15 approximately .25 miles to the traffic light. Turn right onto HWY 82 for 6 miles. Turn left onto HWY 89 for 6 miles into Irvine. At the fourth light turn left onto HWY 52 and proceed through Ravenna. Follow instruction in the paragraph above.

From Eastern areas: Take Mountain Parkway north to the Slade exit. Turn left onto HWY 11 towards Beattyville. After 13 miles turn right onto HWY 498. At the dead end take a right onto HWY 52. Go 6 miles and take a right onto HWY 1746 which will lead you straight to camp.
